

COOKIE POLICY

1 Policy Regarding the Use of Cookies

The present Policy governs the application of cookies at www.atancfesztivalja.hu (hereinafter: "website") operated by Pannon Várszínház Non-profit Ltd. Please read the followings carefully before starting to use the website.

What are cookies?

Cookies are IT data, files, or information packages (including but not exclusively consisting of text files) which are stored on the user's computer (or any other internet-enabled device such as mobile phone or tablet) when the user visits a website. Cookies are generated by the web server itself with the employment of a browser on the user's device, where they are stored in a separate folder. Following this, the browser sends the contents of cookies to the web server on every website download, enabling the website to subsequently load according to the given user's settings while maintaining total anonymity.

What do we use cookies for?

The primary aim of cookies is to enhance user experience, i.e. easier website use, customisation, and faster loading. Furthermore, we use cookies to compile anonymous statistics to better grasp how visitors use our website, and to enable us improve its structure and contents. Information gathered in this way is anonymous and is only used for website development.

What types of cookies do we use?

Two types of cookies are used on our website: "Session cookies", which remain stored on your device until you leave the website or log out from the website. "Fixed cookies" remain stored on your device depending on their duration period and your browser settings, or until they are manually deleted from the user's device. The use of cookies on possible partner websites is always governed by the given partner's cookie policy.

2 Protection of personal data

Data collected by cookies is exclusively used to enhance user experience and operation to individual settings in a way that no third party gains access to them; furthermore, we do not pass data on to any third party.

Deletion of cookies

Default settings for most internet browsers will accept cookies. Default settings may be changed by blocking cookies, or you may request notifications on what cookies are used by the website you have visited. For further information or to change your settings please read the instructions of your browser under Help, or study the settings of your mobile device. In the event that you block the acceptance of cookies, or refuse accepting cookies in any other way, the website may not operate perfectly.
